Entries: The deadline for pre-entering the trial is August 10. Entries received or paid after August 10 are considered post-entries and may not be able to race. GTG move-ups are at your original entry fee. Pre-entry fees per class are \$14.00 for MWJRTC members and \$ 17.00 for non-members. The post-entry fee for everyone is \$ 17.00 per class. No post-entries for racing unless heats are not full and approved by officials.

Trial Vault: We accept online registrations through the Trial Vault system. To access Trial Vault, go to <https://v3.trialvault.dog/>. If you prefer not to pre-register for classes, we urge you to create a free account with Trial Vault by the August 10 pre- registration deadline so your information can be accessed if you come to the trial. There is a \$25.00 fee if we must set up your account during the trial. If you need help creating a Trial Vault account or registering for the trial, please contact Trisha Frankenberg at trialecretary@mwjrctc.com

Payment: Pre-entries are not considered complete until payment is received on or before August 10. Payment may be made by credit card on Trial Vault with Stripe or separately with PayPal. To pay with PayPal, click [here](#) or send payments to treasurer@mwjrctc.com. You do not need a PayPal account to pay by credit card. There is a \$ 5.00 handling fee added to PayPal/Stripe credit card payments. If paying by check or money order, send it to the Club Treasurer, Greg Mode, N3075 Trieloff Rd, Fort Atkinson, WI 53538. No need to include registration documents. Just write Summer Celebration in memo section of the check. All payments must be in U.S. dollars. There is a \$ 40.00 fee for returned checks.

Refund Policy: Credit card payments including the \$ 5.00 handling charge will be refunded minus the 4.0% fee charged to us by Stripe and PayPal. If paid by check, uncashed checks will be shredded or returned. If checks were cashed, refund checks will be mailed after the trial. For prepaid entry fees, 100% minus fees will be refunded for entries withdrawn on or before August 10. 100% minus fees will be refunded for bitches in heat when presented with a veterinary certificate dated on or after August 10 that certifies the bitch entered was in heat. 50% minus fees will be refunded for entries withdrawn after August 10 but before August 17. NO REFUND will be issued for no-shows or cancellations received on or after August 17. Full refund minus PayPal/Stripe fees if we cancel the trial due to COVID-19 issues.

Club membership: To support & join our club, go to our website, www.midwestjackrussellterrierclub.com, and complete the online application process. Prior to receiving Club benefits the application & payment must be received. Example of Club benefit: Members only pre-entry fees for this trial.

JRTCA Administration fees and membership: Your JRTs do not have to be registered or recorded with the JRTCA to attend a sanctioned trial but you must be a member of the JRTCA. This rule does not apply to people entering only non-sanctioned classes. Adult JRTs who are registered or recorded and puppies not yet eligible for registration/recording pay an administration fee of \$ 2.00 per dog per day. The fee for JRTs who are not registered or recorded is \$ 7.00 per dog per day. To become a member of JRTCA, go to www.therealjackrussell.com/jrtca/jrtcaprt.php and complete the online application or use the membership application on the last page of this flyer.

Championship Certificate Classes: Copies of the certificates must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries or shown to the trial secretary or den stewards at the trial. For Working Conformation classes, a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate is required. To qualify for Go-To-Ground and Super Earth Championship Certificate classes, your terriers must have the corresponding certificates. For more information about obtaining certificates, see the JRTCA web site link, www.therealjackrussell.com/breed/certificates.php.

Puppies under the age of three months and bitches in season are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this JRTCA rule will be excused from all classes and asked to leave the trial site. This includes the camping area, RVs and vehicles on the trial site. There will be no refunds and we are required to document violations. Violators may be subject to additional penalties.

Conformation Ringside Parking: **Reserve spaces in Trial Vault in the “Extras” section along** with your entries. Spaces are approximately 10 feet x 10 feet and will be arranged as appropriate for COVID-19 guidelines. Spaces assigned on a first come, first served basis with preference given to two-day reservations. Cost is \$ 20.00 for two days (Saturday & Sunday) or \$ 15.00 per day (if available). Please let us know if you want to be located near another exhibitor, if possible, we will comply to your request. Reservations will be confirmed.

Jack Russell Terrier Ribbons & Awards: Champion & Reserve and Best & Reserve Ribbons & Awards for Conformation. Champion & Reserve Ribbons & Awards for Racing, GTG, Super Earth, Trailing & Locating, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt, Thunder Tunnel, Nose Work & Lure. High Score Champion & Reserve Ribbons & Awards for Agility. High Score & Reserve for Youth Handler & Child Handler. Ribbons for Bronze Medallion Celebration. Ribbons & Awards for High-Point Versatility. First - Sixth place Ribbons for all classes.

Jack Russell Terrier High-Point Versatility Awards: These 2 non-sanctioned awards highlight the versatility of our JRT Puppy & Adults (1 year & older). To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in Trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices. Points are accumulated each day for the ribbons-awards, which are presented at the end of each day. For details on how to earn points, see page 20. Non-Sanctioned.

Earthdog Classes & Awards: We offer classes for earthdogs in all events. Earthdog classes are open to Terriers and other earthdog breeds such as dachshunds that measure no more than 15 inches tall at the withers. The Earthdog classes are not open to JRTs registered or recorded with the JRTCA. Ribbon & Award for the High-Point Versatility. First – Sixth place Ribbons for all classes. All earthdog classes are non-sanctioned.

Earthdog High-Point Versatility Award: This award highlights the versatility of our Earthdogs. To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in Trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices. Points are accumulated each day for the award, which is presented at the end of each day. For details on how to earn points, see page 20. Non-Sanctioned.

Players Golf Cars must receive your reservation and payment by 4 p.m. CST on Thurs., August 8, 2024. The rate is \$ 200.00 for the weekend plus a fair share of the amount for the delivery & pickup. The Club coordinates delivery on Friday & pickup on Monday. You will be asked to provide your name, email address, mobile phone number, number of carts, type of cart (box or four-passenger), and a credit/debit card for payment.

Camping: **This year, all reservations are made through Trial Vault in the “Extras” section, no need to fill** out a separate form. When reserving a campsite, help us improve your stay by providing your vehicle type, preferred location and electrical hookup and water needs. We honor requests in the order received. Assignments are made the Sunday before the Summer Celebration and will be sent to the email you provided with your entries. Your trial packet may include a permit to display on your windshield. The charge for RV camping is \$ 45.00 per night or \$ 90.00 for the trial weekend (Thursday p.m. through Monday a.m.). The tent and overnight vehicle parking charge is \$ 25.00 per night. Your stay includes access to shower and toilet facilities 24/7 as well as waste & trash disposal. Please pay camping fees with your Trial Vault entry.

See the fairgrounds map on page 21. In the far northeast corner of the fairground’s property is the “Outback”, a large RV park with water, 30-amp & 50-amp electric hookups and an adjacent dump station. Other locations are available with water & 30-amp electrical access. Rough Camping spaces with 20-amp service & water is abundant. For sites outside of the Outback, we recommend you have UL-certified electrical service adaptors, 100 feet of UL-Certified electrical service cord & 100 feet of potable water hose. No camping in conformation ringside spaces.

\$50.00. The last day to reserve a blocked room is August 1st 2024. If reserving rooms outside of the
block there is a 10% discount if you have a military ID and for AARP members. Mention the

about 35 minutes from the trial site.

Food: There will be a food truck at the trial site on Saturday and Sunday.

Raffle: Ticket sales end at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. The drawing takes place at 5:15 p.m. in the Main
Pavilion. Tickets are drawn and the winning tickets attached to prizes. You need not be present during
the drawing but you must be able to take prizes with you or have a friend pick them up. Donate an

RV to the trial site for an additional fee.

JRTCA Sanctioned Trial 2024 Rulebook: There have been some changes to rules for racing, go to ground and
super earth. See the racing information in the class list. For some go-to-ground and super earth classes, the times to
reach quarry are now based on the length of the tunnel. Copies of the rulebook will be available at the trial. It is also

JRTCA National Challenge Awards: If offered this year, this trial qualifies for the JRTCA National Challenge

Youth Division: Information for child and youth competitors can be found in the JRTCA Child and Youth Handbook
and Study Guide available at www.therealjackrussell.com/download/2017_JRTCA_YouthStudyGuide.pdf.

General Rules For All Exhibitors

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be members of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified, and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they entered.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under the Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child or Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division or section which they are judging but may enter the completion in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terries.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for measurement of a terrier in the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races). Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate GTG and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's & campers if at the same address as the trial grounds). (01/22)
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs or an owner's failure to control their dogs, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs, other than JRT's on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be downloaded for the JRTCA website www.therealjackrussell.com
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event. (01/22)
24. **The Judge's decision are final in all Divisions.**

3 to 4 Month Puppy Conformation (non-sanctioned)

Class 1: 3 to 4 month puppy Open to Jack Russell terriers and earthdogs. Designed to give your three- up to 4-month-old puppies exposure to the conformation ring, this non-sanctioned class runs after the youth conformation classes and before regular conformation classes begin.

JRTCA 4 up to 6 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 2: Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months

Class 3: Bitch Pups, 4 up to 6 months.

Class 4: BEST 4 UP TO 6 MONTH PUPPY & RESERVE

Open to the 1st and 2nd place winners of 4 up to 6 month Puppy Classes. No entry fee.

JRTCA 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 5: Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months

Class 6: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months

Class 7: BEST 6 up to 12 months PUPPY DOG & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of 6-12 month puppy dog classes. No entry fee.

Class 8: Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months

Class 9: Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months

Class 10: BEST 6 up to 12 months PUPPY BITCH & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of 6-12 month puppy bitch classes. No entry fee.

Class 11: PUPPY CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Best Dog Puppy & Reserve and Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve. No entry fee.

JRTCA Working Terrier Conformation

Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. Terriers entering the Working Section may not cross-enter into the Open Section; no cross-entering is permitted within the Working Section.

Recognition of the Working Jack Russell Terrier Ceremony**Sponsored by Devon Working Terriers**

Class 12: Recognition of the Working Jack Russell Terrier Ceremony

Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field and/or a working achievement award for continued field service. **Class #12 is held on SATURDAY ONLY.** No entry Fee

Class 13: Bronze Medallion Dogs

Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 14: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Dogs

Open to any Working Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 15: Working Terrier Dogs, 10" up to 12½"

Class 16: Working Terrier Dogs, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 17: Working Veteran Terrier Dogs. Open to working terrier dogs, six years and older.

Class 18: BEST WORKING TERRIER DOG & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Working Terrier Dog classes. No entry fee.

Class 19: Bronze Medallion Bitches

Open to any bitch which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 20: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Bitches

Open to any Working Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 21: Working Terrier Bitches, 10" up to 12½"

Class 22: Working Terrier Bitches, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 23: Working Veteran Terrier Bitches. Open to working terrier bitches, six years and older.

Class 24: BEST WORKING TERRIER BITCH & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Working Terrier Bitch classes. No entry fee.

Class 25: WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE

Open to Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve and Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve. No entry fee.

JRTCA Open Adult Conformation

Cross-entering is not permitted within the Open Section and between the Open Section and the Working Section.

Class 26: Bred by Exhibitor Dogs

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Open Bitch classes. No entry fee.

Class 34: BEST OPEN TERRIER & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Best Dog & Reserve and Best Bitch & Reserve. No entry fee.

JRTCA Breeder's Classes

Class 35: Stud Dog and Get

Open to Sire with at least 2, but no more than 3 offspring at side. Judged on Breed Standard & Consistency of Type. Stud Dog must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Open to Dam with at least 2, but no more than 3 offspring at side. Judged on Breed Standard & Consistency of Type. Brood bitch must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Stud Dog and Get and Brood Bitch and Produce. No entry fee.

Class 38: Skip - Not used as a class

Class 39: Working Family

Open to working stud dogs and working brood bitches with at least two, but no more than three adult working offspring at side. All terriers must have earned and received one or more JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificates.

RACING

JUDGE'S BRIEFING AT 8:15 A.M. Adult terriers may not cross-enter between regular racing classes, veteran racing classes and senior racing classes. Racing champions are determined by a run-off of the first-place terrier in each class in each section. Racing ribbons presented in main pavilion after racing is completed.

Qualifications for Championship Run Off: **A.** Terriers must place 1st in a Flat or Hurdle race final to qualify for Championship Run Offs. **B.** A terrier MUST ENTER AND FINISH in both, at least one flat AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final). **C.** A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final champion race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in final. **D.** A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier. **E.** In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second-place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above. Class 94: Over 12 ½" UP TO 15" VETERAN CHAMPION & RESERVE

Open to 1st place winners of sanctioned, over 12 ½" up to 15", veteran racing classes. No entry fee.

Earthdog Steeplechase Races Non Sanctioned

Class 95: Earthdog Puppy, 6 up to 12 months Height is limited to Earthdogs 15" and under.

Class 96: Earthdog Adult, 1 year and older Height is limited to Earthdogs 15" and under.

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is NOT permitted (any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from Go-To-Ground at this trial). *For all GTG classes:* Terriers may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying). Work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing work for a period of more than 10 seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of view of the judge. The judge may halt the work if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself.

Class 97: Pre-Novice JRT Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies, 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter until quarry is reached; work quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work & without leaving quarry.

Class 98: Novice JRT Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies, 6 up to 12 months, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work & without leaving the quarry.

Class 99: Novice JRT Adult

Open to Jack Russells, one year of age or older, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Adult class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work & without leaving the quarry.

Class 100: Open JRT Puppy

Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months, which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy GTG class at future trials. Open Puppy GTG is NOT open to any puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work & without leaving quarry.

Class 101: Open JRT Adult

Open to Jack Russells, 1 year or older, which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Terriers which score 100% in the Open Adult class, are eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when the terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work & without leaving quarry.

Class 102: JRT Puppy Championship

Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months, which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once & re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for 1 minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

For ALL Champion Certificate Go-To-Ground Classes listed below: A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class.

CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.

Class 103: 10" up to 12 ½" Adult JRT Championship Certificate

Open to any Adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12 ½", 1 year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First & second place winners will be Under Adult Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 104: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Adult JRT Championship Certificate

Open to any Adult Jack Russell, over 12 ½" up to 15", 1 year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First & second place winners will be Over Adult Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 105: 10" up to 12 ½" Veteran JRT Championship Certificate

Open to any Adult Jack Russell, **10" up to 12 ½"**, 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First & second place winners will be Under Veteran Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.

Class 106: Over 12½" up to **15"** Veteran JRT Championship Certificate

Open to any Adult Jack Russell, over **12 ½" up to 15"**, 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First & second place winners will be Over Veteran Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 107: 10" up to **12½"** Senior JRT Championship Certificate

Open to any Adult Jack Russell, **10" up to 12 ½"**, 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First & second place winners will be Under Senior Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 108: Over 12½" up to 15" Senior JRT Championship Certificate

Open to any Adult Jack Russell, **over 12 ½" up to 15"**, 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First & second place winners will be Over Senior Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Earthdog Go-to-Ground

Class 109: Earthdog Novice Non-Sanctioned

Open to Earthdogs, **up to 15" tall**, 6 months and older, who have NOT scored 100% in a Earthdog Novice GTG at previous trials. Entries earning 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Earthdog Open class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 110: Earthdog Open Non-Sanctioned

Open to Earthdogs, **up to 15" tall**, 6 months and older, who HAVE scored 100% in a Earthdog Novice class at this or previous trials. One second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for 1 minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

A more challenging GTG tunnel is used for this Super Earth course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Terriers, 6 months and older. Schooling prior to the competition is NOT permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from Super Earth Competition at this trial. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying). For Championship Certificate classes, a copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. No cross entering between Certificate classes.

Timing for all Super Earth classes: One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter the earth multiple times until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work & without leaving quarry. Terrier is Not to leave quarry once it is reached. For more info about Super Earth, go to: www.therealjackrussell.com/trial/superearth.php.

Class 111: 6 up to 12 month, Open JRT Puppy Super Earth Open to JRT puppies, 6 up to 12 months. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth at future trials. Open Puppy Super Earth is Not open to any puppy that has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth previously.

Class 112: 10" up to 12 ½", Open Adult JRT Super Earth Open to terriers 1 year & older.

Class 113: Over 12 ½" up to 15", Open Adult JRT Super Earth Open to terriers 1 year & older.

Class 114: 6 up to 12 month, JRT Puppy Champion Super Earth. Open to JRT puppies, 6 up to 12 months, which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12-month Puppy Super Earth class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% scoresheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to the den steward at the time of the class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 115: Adult JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, 10" up to 12 ½" Open to **JRT's**, 1 year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Under Adult Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 116: Adult JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, over 12 ½" up to 15" **Open to JRT's**, 1 year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Adult Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 117: Veteran JRT Championship Certificate Super Earth, 10" up to 12 ½" **Open to JRT's six** years & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Under Veteran Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 118: Veteran JRT Championship Certificate Super Earth, over 12 ½" up to 15" Open to **JRT's** six years & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Veteran Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 119: Senior JRT Championship Certificate Super Earth, **10" up to 12 ½"** Open to **JRT's**, nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Under Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 120: Senior JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, **12 ½" up to 15"** Open to **JRT's**, nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Earthdog Super Earth - Height is limited to Earthdogs 15" and under.

Class 121: Earthdog Super Earth Open to Earthdogs, 6 months and older. Non-sanctioned

No entry fee. The sanctioned Youth Division is open to JRTCA child and/or youth members in the following age brackets: Child Handler (ages 5 thru 9) and Youth Handler (ages 10 thru 16). A child/**youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st** of the current calendar year except for those children turning five years of age. They may begin competing in Child Handler any time following their fifth birthday. All exhibitors in the Youth Division must be current JRTCA members, either under a Family membership or under an individual Youth membership. Youths or their families applying for a JRTCA membership at a Sanctioned Trial will be allowed to enter classes at that trial. Youth exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handling and Youth Go-to-Ground to qualify for the Youth High Score & Reserve. Child exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Child Handling and Child Go-to-Ground to qualify for the Child High Score & Reserve (non-sanctioned). A tie will be broken with the final decision made by a conformation Judge other than the judge of the day. The tiebreaker takes place in the conformation ring and is determined at the judge's discretion by the exhibitor's handling/presentation of his/her terrier, by the answers to the judge's questions, or by a combination of the two. Note: If there is no other available conformation judge on the grounds, then the judge of the day will determine the tiebreaker. Class 51: Child Handler

Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on **child's** ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 52: Youth Handler

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an Adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the **youth's** ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 53: Youth Go to Ground

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an Adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the **youth's** ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go to Ground. To be run through the 10-foot novice liner; time not to be considered. Terriers competing in Youth GTG, if entered in regular GTG classes, must compete in the regular GTG class prior to competing in the Youth GTG class.

Class 54: Child Go to Ground (Non-sanctioned)

Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling an Adult or 6–12-month puppy Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go to Ground. To be run through the 10-foot novice liner; time not to be considered. Terriers competing in Child GTG, if entered in regular GTG classes, must compete in the regular GTG class prior to competing in the Child GTG class.

Class 55: Youth Off-/On-Lead Agility

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16 handling an adult JRT. May choose to participate off or on lead. To be run over the Way To Play agility course. Time not to be considered. Judged on the **youth's** ability to handle his/her terrier and knowledge of agility.

Class 56: YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in Youth Handler, Youth G-T-G and Youth Agility classes. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 points; and participation = 1 point.

Class 57: CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE (Non-sanctioned)

Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner-up in the Child Handler and Child GTG classes. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 points; and participation = 1 point.

Trailing & Locating

Trailing & Locating is a sanctioned event that involves the terrier tracking and locating a quarry above ground. The terrier is judged on his ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on the quarry. The terrier is judged on a combination of time and accuracy. The terrier with the fastest time is not necessarily the winner. Course length is a minimum of 50 steps long with at least two direction changes but no more than four direction changes. Event is in a fenced area. The trail is scented with mixture of rat excrement, water, and unscented glycerin.

Class 154: Miscellaneous Dog Barn Hunt Non-Sanctioned

Open to all breeds other than JRTs and earthdogs, 6 months older.

Brush hunt is an above-ground hunting simulation held in a fenced area. One camouflaged tube containing a live rat is hidden within the brush area. The challenge is for the terrier to use natural instincts to successfully locate and work the quarry. Terrier must work to find the quarry in the shortest amount of time. The clock starts when the judge is ready and signals you to release your dog at the gate. All four paws must be on the ground before you release your dog. The judge stops the clock when your dog has found the tube. You do not enter with the dog, but you can encourage your dog verbally. No hand signals allowed. The dog must locate the tube to have a qualifying time. No cross-entering between classes. Maximum time allowed is two minutes.

FRIDAY (Only) STAKES BARN HUNT EVENT Non Sanctioned

This year at the Summer Celebration Terrier Trial, we will hold a Stakes Barn Hunt Event on Friday, August 16th from 11:00 – 3:00; sign-up starts at 10:30 that morning. Cost is \$20.00 per dog, cash payments only, no trial vault entry, pay at Barn Hunt Stakes course. Maximum of 50 dogs will be allowed to enter. All dogs/all breeds/all ages are welcome to compete.

50% of the total purse will go to the Summer Celebration Trial as a fund raiser to help cover overall trial costs. The other 50% will be split up between the fastest 5 qualifying times as follows: 1st place = 30%, 2nd place = 25%, 3rd place = 20%, 4th place = 15%, 5th place = 10%. Awards will be announced at the Friday Potluck Dinner.

There will be 3 rats in tubes, and 1 tube with just litter in it. Each dog has 2 minutes 30 seconds on the course to find all 3 rats. At the end of 2 minutes 30 seconds, time is up. Dogs who do not find all 3 rats within 2 minutes 30 seconds do not have a qualifying time. When the dog finds a rat, the owner must call it out to the judge. The owner must then restrain the dog while the rat handler removes the tube from the course. If the owner does not restrain the dog, the handler will not remove the tube. The judge will keep track of the number of rats found. When the dog has found all 3 rats the judge will record final time.

If the handler calls out “rat” when the dog has actually found a tube with litter, this will cost the dog an additional 10 seconds added to their time. The litter tube will not be removed from the course. If the dog and handler identify the litter tube a second time, it will result in DQ.

Handlers can walk along with their dogs and talk to their dogs throughout the course. Handlers cannot touch their dogs nor any part of the course except when restraining their terrier when the rat is being removed from the course. When restraining the dog, at least two of its feet must remain in contact with the ground/hay bales.

Dogs may not bite or lay teeth on the rat handler while a rat tube is being removed from the course. This will result in immediate DQ, and dog and owner will be asked to leave the course. The rat handler will not pick up the tube to remove it until the handler has effectively restrained their dog. Dogs should not be allowed to manhandle the rat tube too excessively. Excessive roughness with the rat may result in DQ by the judge.

All terriers must be at least one year of age to compete in JRTCA Agility or practice on any equipment. Dogs may run naked or wear one flat collar without tags. No other accoutrements are allowed. No food or toys are allowed within 10 feet of the ring. **Exceptions are that toys are allowed for the class “A Way to Play”. A Beginner Agility certificate may be earned prior to competing in Advanced Agility & for Agility High Score Champion & Reserve. Move ups from Beginner Agility to Advanced Agility are allowed from trial to trial. (Example: 2nd Beginner leg is earned at Saturday’s trial; the team could move to Advanced Agility for Sunday’s trial). As a JRTCA certificate has not been issued both qualifying score sheets must be presented to move up. Advanced Agility competitors may cross enter the Beginner Agility class For Exhibit Only (FEO) to be used as a warmup run. No ribbons will be rewarded, and no paperwork completed for an FEO run. Teams with two scores of 190 or greater in the agility classes (Beginner and Advanced) are eligible for agility certificates. Teams with one qualifying score of 200 in Jumpers are eligible for the Jumpers certificate. For a complete set of rules, go to www.therealjackrussell.com/trial/agility.php.**

Jump Heights – The “Under” category will jump 8”. The “Over” category will jump 12” as an Adult & owners’ decision of 8” or 12” as a Veteran. Seniors will jump 4” regardless of height of the terrier.

Note: Sat & Sun Obstacle Familiarization: \$5 per run, sign up for these runs on the Add-On Section of Trial Vault or on the entry form. Can make multiple runs as time & number of entries allow.

Class 128: JRT A Way To Play:

This class is designed for the true beginner and should be used to foster attention, interaction, reward and playing with your partner. Toys (tugs, drags, and squeaky) are allowed & encouraged. No food is allowed. Teams have 60 seconds to earn 15 points. A buzzer or whistle will sound at the end of 60 seconds & teams have 5 seconds to reach the finish obstacle (either table or designated jump). Teams must successfully complete at least one 5-point obstacle, one 3-point obstacle and one 1-point obstacle.

Class 129: JRT Beginner Agility: (Previously Agility 1)

1.75 yd/sec, 11-14 obstacles. Complete at least one contact, minimum of two tunnels & single bar jumps.

Class 130: JRT Advance Agility: (Previously Agility 11)

2.25 yd/sec, 15-18 obstacles. Must complete at least two up to three contact obstacles. Can be either same obstacle or different ones. Must complete either one set of 12 weaves OR two sets of 6 weaves. Must complete at least one spread jump (double, triple, broad or wall). Must complete 2-3 tunnels.

Class 131: JRT Jumpers

2 yds/sec, 15-18 obstacles, Single bar jumps, with or without wings, is acceptable. Minimum of one up to three spread jumps. Maximum of 3 tunnels.

Class 132: JRT Full House (Point Accumulation Game)

This is a time management game which requires the team to reach the finish obstacle prior to 40 seconds. For every second over 40 seconds, the team will lose one point. A qualifying score of 25 points or above within the time limit. Each obstacle can be completed twice for points. Teams must complete a minimum of one 5-point obstacle, two-3 point obstacles, and 3 single bar jumps.

Class 133: JRT HIGH SCORE AGILITY CHAMPION & RESERVE

Points will be accumulated from Advanced Agility, Jumpers, and Full House (Point Accumulation Game) for the High Point Champion & Reserve. Advanced Agility & Jumpers are each worth 200 points. These points will be combined with the Point Accumulation Game points earned. Jumpers must be a qualifying score (200 points) to earn a High Score Championship, though it does not stop the team from earning a Reserve High Score Championship. If all teams earn faults in the Jumpers class, a Championship can still be awarded to the highest combined point accumulation of the three classes. All ties will be broken by the fastest accumulated time of the three classes. No entry fee.

Saturday Only

NOSE WORK

Open to dogs six months and older who are capable of alerting to the target odors. Level 1 target odor is birch. Level 2 target odors are birch, anise and clove. A Level 1 title is not required to enter Level 2 classes. Time faults incurred for dropped food, failure to go through start-line marker, excessive disturbance of search area, incorrect call in Level 1 and failure to call finish in Level 2 searches. Eliminating (pee, poop or vomit) in a search area ends the search and results in a non-qualifying score and no placement. Consult the rulebook for more detailed information. First through sixth ribbons for each class determined by correct calls with fastest time first. Champion and reserve champion ribbons awarded to top two JRTs in Level 1 and top two JRTs in Level 2 by combining scores for all elements/classes. Teams with no faults considered first.

Class 137: JRT Beginner Sniffer: Open to dogs who have not shown in any other nose work venue. Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers (same as Level 1) placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart with 1 birch hide. Two minute time limit. One incorrect call is allowed. Placement ribbons only. Not eligible for the championship.

Class 138: JRT Level 1 Container Search: Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart with 1 birch hide and a 2-minute time limit. Can be set up in 1 straight line or 2 straight rows. Teams must go through start-line **markers and call “alert” when hide is found.** One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.

Class 139: JRT Level 1 Exterior Search: Search area will be between 100 and 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Hide will be no higher than 12 inches and will not be buried in the ground. Teams must go through start-line **markers and call “alert” when hide is found.** Time limit is two minutes. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.

Class 140: JRT Level 2 Container Search: Consists of 10 to 14 containers spaced at least 2 feet apart in any configuration. Can be any type of container that is not transparent. Containers do not have to be identical and can be elevated up to 24 inches. There are 2 hides. Can be birch, anise, or clove. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call **“alert” when hides are found and “finish” after the second hide is found.** Incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Time limit is 2:30 minutes.

Class 141: JRT Level 2 Exterior Search: Search area will be at least 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Hides are placed no higher than 24 inches and will not be buried in the ground. There are two hides. Can be birch, anise or clove. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call **“alert” when hides are found and “finish”** after the second hide is found. An incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Search time between 2:30 minutes and 4 minutes is determined by the judge.

Class 142: JRT Level 1 Nose Work Champion & Reserve

To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 1 classes offered. At this trial, the scores for the Level 1 Container class and Level 1 Exterior classes are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons are awarded to the top two dogs. No entry Fee.

Class 143: JRT Level 2 Nose Work Champion & Reserve

To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 2 classes offered. At this trial, the scores for the Level 2 Container class and Level 2 Exterior classes are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons are awarded to the top two dogs. No Entry Fee.

EARTHDOG NOSEWORK non-sanctioned.

Open to earthdogs capable of alerting to target odors of birch, anise and clove. Same rules as JRT Nose Work classes. May enter both Level 1 and Level 2 classes.

Class 144: Earthdog Level 1 Container Search: Eight to 10 identical containers placed on the floor and spaced at least two feet apart with one birch hide and a two-minute time limit. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.

Class 145: Earthdog Level 1 Exterior Search: Clearly marked search area will be between 100 and 200 square feet. Hide no higher than 12 inches and not buried in the ground. Teams must go through start-line **markers and call “alert” when hide is found.** Time limit is two minutes. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.

Class 146: Earthdog Level 2 Container Search: Consists of 10 to 14 containers of any type spaced at least two feet apart in any configuration. Do not have to be identical and can be elevated up to 24 inches. There are two hides-birch, anise or clove. Teams must go through start-line **markers. Handlers must call “alert” when hides are found and “finish” after the second hide is found.** An incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Time limit is 2:30 minutes.

Class 147: Earthdog Level 2 Exterior Search: Clearly marked search area will be at least 200 square feet. Hides are placed no higher than 24 inches and will not be buried in the ground. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call **“alert” when hides are found and “finish” after the second hide is found.** Incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Search time between 2:30 minutes and 4 minutes is determined by the judge.

JRT & Earthdog High-Point Versatility Awards

Points awarded are: 1 point for participation; 2 points for sixth place; 3 points for fifth place; 4 points for fourth place; 5 points for third place; 6 points for second place; 8 points for first place. Go to Ground will be the tiebreaker.

Class 181: JRT Puppy High-Point Versatility Award

Open to Jack Russell Terrier puppies, 6 up to 12 months old. Your highest point, from one class in the offered division, will be accumulated each day. The High-Point Versatility Award will be presented at the end of each day. The divisions offered for the award are: Conformation, Racing, Go to Ground, Super Earth, Trailing & Locating, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt, Lure Coursing, Thunder Tunnel, & Nose Work. To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in Trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices.

No entry fee. Non-sanctioned.

Class 182: JRT Adult High-Point Versatility Award

Open to Adult Jack Russell Terriers 1 year and older. Your highest point, from one class in the offered division, will be accumulated each day. The High-Point Versatility Award will be presented at the end of each day. The divisions offered for the award are: Conformation, Racing, Go to Ground, Super Earth, Trailing & Locating, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt, Lure Coursing, Thunder Tunnel, Agility & Nose Work. To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in Trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices.

No entry fee. Non-sanctioned.

Class 183: Earthdog High-Point Versatility Award

Open to Earthdogs 6 months & older. Your highest point, from one class in the offered division, will be accumulated each day. The High-Point Versatility Award will be presented at the end of each day. The divisions offered for the award are: Conformation, Racing, Go to Ground, Super Earth, Trailing & Locating, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt, Lure Coursing, Thunder Tunnel, Agility & Nose Work. To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in Trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices.
