



MWJRTC Sponsored Puppy Membership Program

Introduced by the 2017-2018 Midwest JRT Club board of directors as an initiative to assist with JRT puppy development, promote JRTCA membership, and increase the awareness of what a Jack Russell Terrier is and can be (Breed Education). The program provides for a no fee “new” membership in the Midwest JRT Club to JRT puppy purchasers and requires sponsorship by a JRTCA breeder in good standing with the Midwest JRT Club.

Program Details:

- Applies for purchasers of a JRT puppy not more than one year old from a JRTCA breeder in good standing with the JRTCA and Midwest Jack Russell Terrier Club.
- JRTCA Breeder is the mentor and 1st point of contact within the club for JRT and organizational matters.
- Available only as a new membership (single or regular).
- 1st year/current membership dues are waived.
- Application must occur the same year as the JRT puppy purchase.

Breeder Responsibilities:

- Must be a member in good standing with both the JRTCA and Midwest JRT Club.
- Registers with the Club Secretary and Breed Education Trustee as a program participant and sponsor.
- Offers the program to all JRT puppy purchasers that meet new membership criteria for the Midwest JRT Club.
- Is a reasonably active member/participant in Midwest JRT Club activities.
- Agrees to act as a mentor for the sponsored membership.
- Assists with the application process by providing their kennel name and other required information necessary for proper application completion.

New Midwest JRT Club Member/Applicant agrees to and understands:

- All/any other new membership incentives are waived.
- Membership is applicable only for the current membership year.
- Continued membership in the Midwest JRT Club must be renewed at the then current rate.
- The sponsoring breeder is their 1st point of contact in the Midwest Jack Russell Terrier Club.
